McCoun, and the defendant Mary E. Bell being duly called to answer, plead or demurrer to the petition of plaintiff herein filed, but came not, nor answered, and thereupon being in default herein and the court finding that due and legal service of the notice herein of the pendency of this action has been as by law required served upon the ^{said} defendant, and the plaintiff introduced his evidence in support of his said cause of action, and the court being fully advised in the premises as to the truth of the allegations in said plaintiff petition finds that the same are true.

It is therefore considered ordered and ~~adjudged~~ that the marriage relation heretofore existing between the plaintiff Jonathan J. Bell and the defendant Mary E. Bell, be set aside and held for naught, and that each the ~~de~~plaintiff and defendant have for them selves exclusive control of property hereafter acquired and that the costs in this action be taxed to the plaintiff Jonathan J. Bell, and that the same be paid before the decree issues herein.
