Surgeon General reports that David J. Flint died Nov 29, 1862, at Hospital No 6, Louisville Ky. of Pneumonia.

Widow's Claim for Pension.

The State of Ohio, County of Washington, ss.

On this seventeenth day of February, A. D., 1863, personally appeared before (1) Chas. H. Hull, Judge of the Probate Court, a Court of Record within and for said county, Mary A. Flint aged 32 years, a resident of Bloomfield, in the county of Washington, and State of Ohio, who, being first duly sworn according to law, doth, on her oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress approved July 14, 1862: (2)

That she is the widow of David C. Flint who was a Private in Company C., commanded by Captain L. E. Sisson, in the 77th Regiment of Inf., commanded by Colonel J. J. Alderbrand in the war of 1861. (3)

That her said husband died at Louisville Ky. Hospital No. 6, in the State of Kentucky, on the 23rd day of November, A. D. 1862 (4) of disease contracted while in service but the disease not known to Applicant, but understood to be P. pneumonia

while in the line of duty in the service of the United States.

She further declares that she was married to the said David C. Flint at the county of Washington, on the sixteenth day of September, A. D., 1858, by one James M. Groves, a Justice of the Peace; that her name before her marriage was Mary A. Venbow, and that ever since the death of her said husband, she has remained a widow: as will more fully appear by reference to the proof annexed. (5)

That during the existence of the aforesaid marriage there were born to her and her said husband the following named children, who are now under the age of sixteen years, viz:

Charlot Flint, born the eleventh day of August, 1859; Vincent E. Flint born July 30th, 1861.

all of whom are still living, and reside in Bloomfield, as above

She also declares that she has in no manner been engaged in, or aided or abetted, the Rebellion in the United States.

Also personally appeared Henry Scott and Thomas Danbow, residents of Washington in the County of Washington, and State of Ohio, persons whom I certify to be respectable and entitled to credit, and who, being by me duly sworn, say that they were present and saw Mary A Flint sign her name (6) to the foregoing declaration. They further swear that they were acquainted with the said David D Flint, deceased, in his life-time, and know that he and the said Mary A Flint lived and cohabited together as man and wife, up to the time when he entered the service, and that they were generally recognized as such by their acquaintances and neighbors, and their marriage was never questioned. That during the continuance of said marriage there were born to them the following named children, all of whom are now under the age of sixteen years, viz: (7) Charlotte Flint and Vincent E. Flint.

That since the death of her said husband, the said Mary A Flint has not married, but is still a widow; and that she is the identical person she represents herself to be. All the foregoing statements they make from their own personal knowledge; and they have no interest in the prosecution of this claim.



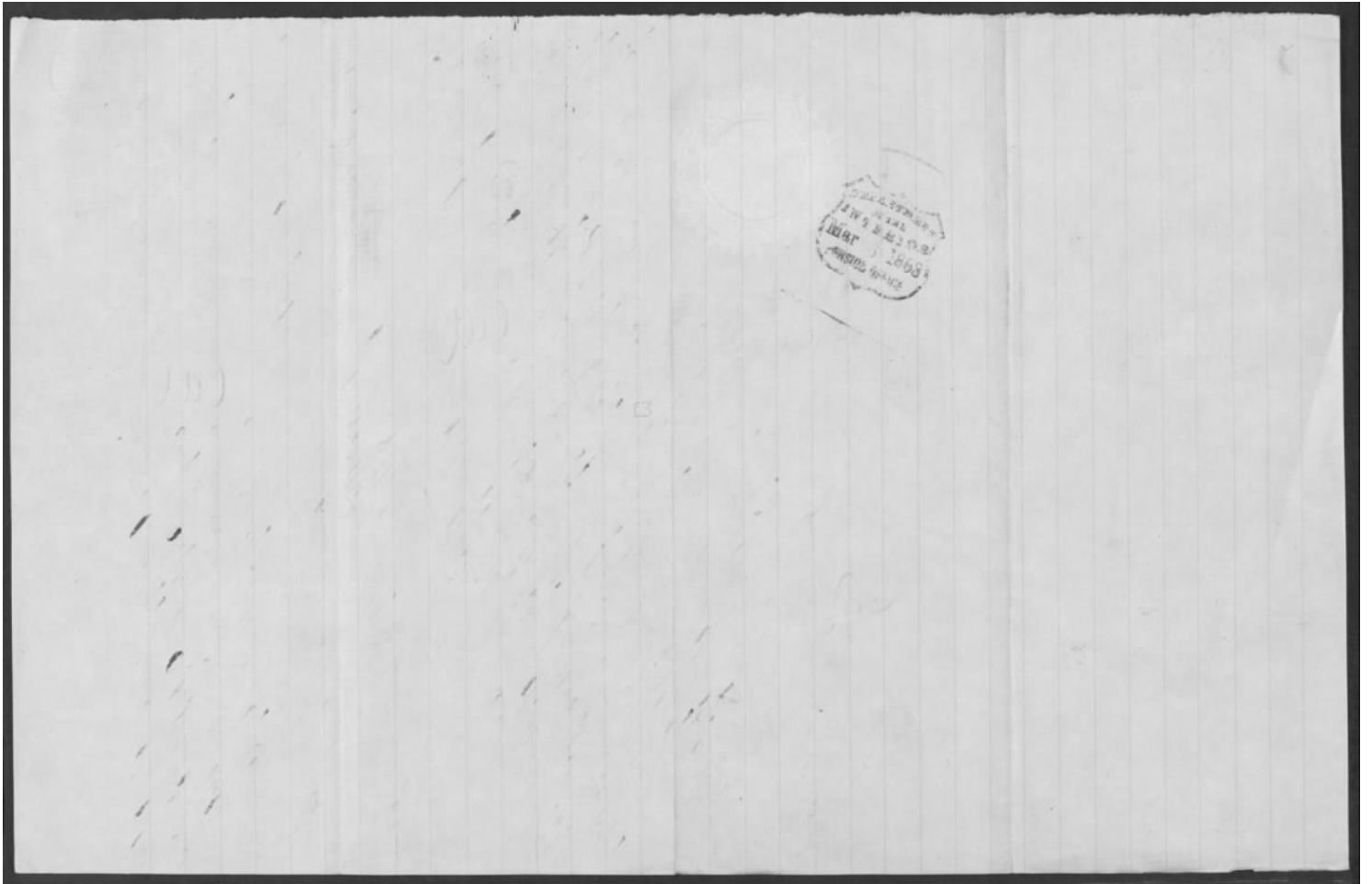

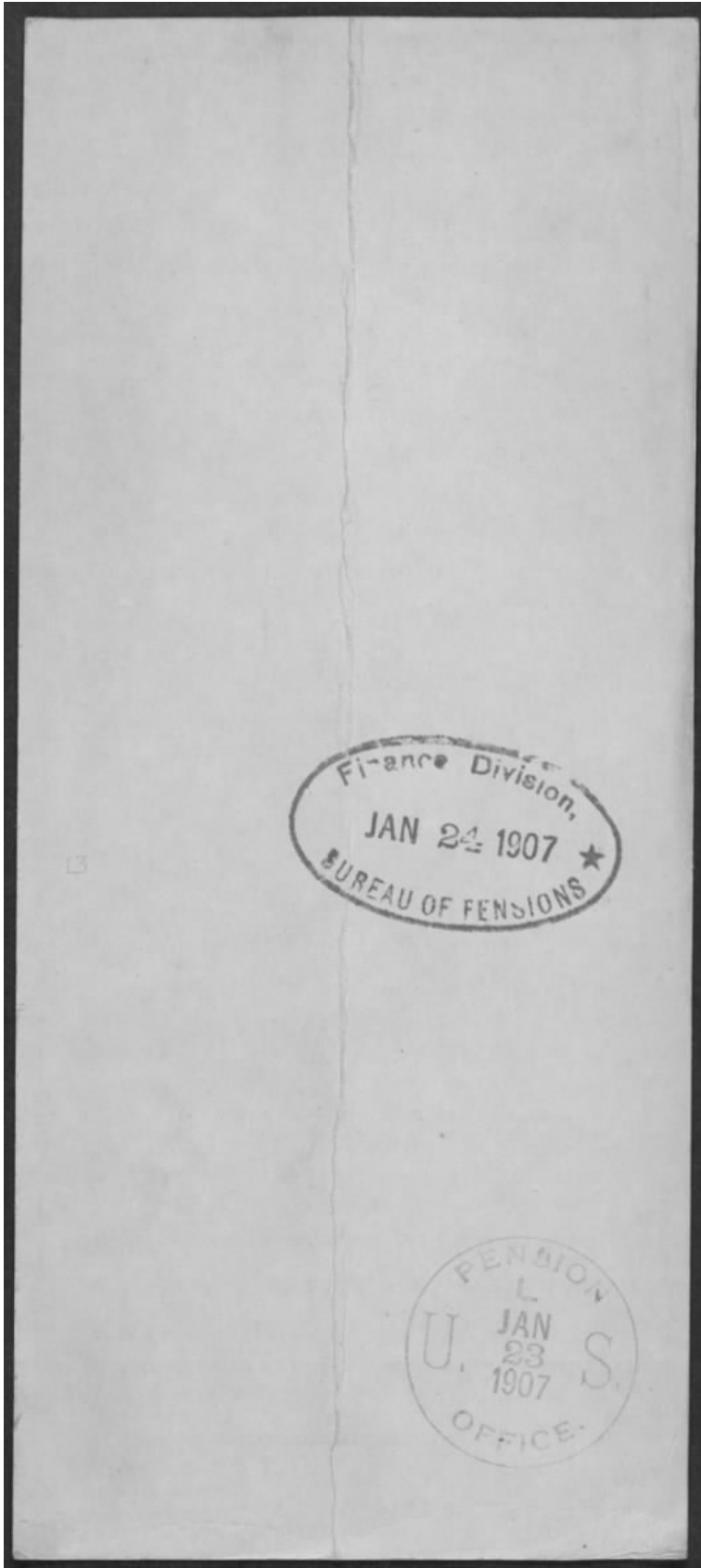
